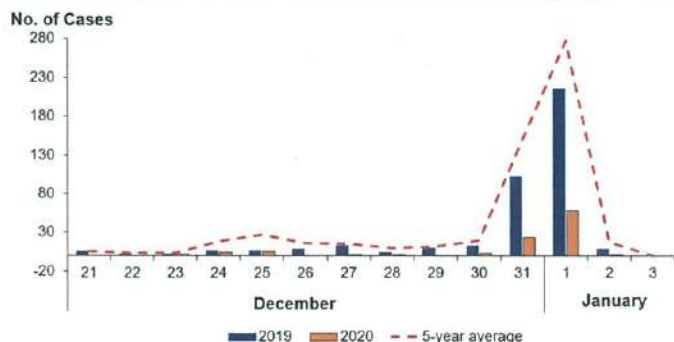

Injury Registry Update of Sentinel Hospitals

There were 18 additional cases of fireworks-related injuries reported by the sentinel hospitals. These bring the total to 100 cases from 6:00 AM of December 21, 2020 to 5:59 AM of January 3, 2021. This is 300 cases (75%) lower compared to 2019 and 475 cases (83%) lower versus the five-year average (2015-2019), same time period (Figure 1).

There were 99 (99%) cases of injuries due to fireworks and one (1%) stray bullet injury. There was no fireworks ingestion reported. No death was reported. Most injuries occurred in NCR and Region I (Table 1).

A. Injuries due to Fireworks

Seventy-one (72%) cases were males. Ages ranged from 2 to 57 years old (Median: 18). Seventy-two (73%) had blast/burn injury not requiring amputation, 24 (24%) had eye injuries, and four (4%) had blast/burn injury involving amputation.

Sixty-three cases (64%) were passive users. Fifty-three (54%) occurred at street. The most affected areas were hands, eyes, and forearms/arms (Table 2).

Fifty-seven injuries (58%) were due to legal fireworks. The top firework involved was kwitis (Table 3).

There was no additional case and total remains one.
